**Proposed Tax Levy
(Renewal)
Hillsdale Local School District**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of three existing taxes for the benefit of the Hillsdale Local School District for the purpose of **current expenses** at a rate not exceeding 20.1 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$2.10 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2015, first due in calendar year 2016.

Norwayne Local School District**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Norwayne Local School District for the purpose of renovation and repair of school buildings, improvement of school sites, purchase of new equipment and replacement of obsolete equipment, at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.20 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2015, first due in calendar year 2016.

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Orrville City School District for the purpose of

providing for the emergency requirements of the school district

in the sum of \$1,115,700 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average 5 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.50 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 10 years, commencing in 2015, first due in calendar year 2016?

Rittman Exempted Village School District

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall a levy renewing an existing levy be imposed by the Rittman Exempted Village School District for the purpose of **avoiding an operating deficit** in the sum of \$950,000 and a levy of taxes to be made outside of the ten-mill limitation estimated by the county auditor to average 9.6 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.96 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 10 years, commencing in 2016, first due in calendar year 2017?

Southeast Local School District PROPOSED BOND ISSUE

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

Shall bonds be issued by the Southeast Local School District for the purpose of **constructing, adding to, renovating, remodeling, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving school district buildings and facilities and clearing, improving and equipping their sites** in the principal amount of \$20,859,063, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 35 years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the county auditor to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 3.56 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 35.6 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2015, first due in calendar year 2016, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

Baughman Township Road District**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Baughman Township Road District for the purpose of construction and repair of township roads and bridges at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.20 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2015, first due in calendar year 2016.

(Precincts: Both Baughman Twp. precincts, with the exception of Marshallville Village residents)

Wayne County**

A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Wayne County for the purpose of providing for the support of Children Services and the care and placement of abused, neglected and dependent children at a rate not exceeding 0.2 mill for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to \$0.02 for each one hundred dollars of valuation, for 5 years, commencing in 2015, first due in calendar year 2016.
