

The Board of Elections of Wayne County, Ohio, issues this Proclamation and Notice of Election.


A **General Election** will be held on Tuesday, the 5th day of November, 2024, at the usual place of holding elections in each and every precinct in Wayne County or at such places as the Board may designate, for the purpose of choosing the following offices: President and Vice President of the United States; Justices of the Ohio Supreme Court (including an Unexpired Term Election); U. S. Senator; Representative to Congress, 7th District; State Representative, 77th District; Judge of the Court of Appeals, 9th District; County Commissioners; County Auditor (Unexpired Term); Prosecuting Attorney; Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas; Sheriff; County Recorder; County Treasurer; County Engineer; County Coroner; and Member of the State Board of Education, 11th District and determining the following questions & issues: State Issue 1, one Village tax levy, two City tax levies, three Township tax levies, three school tax levies (including two overlapping from Ashland County), two Fire District levies, one Road District levy, one Park District levy, one County Children Services levy, five local option questions, and one question to repeal a school district income tax.
