

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Council of the City of Rittman, passed on the 13th day of January, 2025, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the Special Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 6th day of May, 2025 the question of levying a tax, in excess of the ten mill limitation, for the benefit of the City of Rittman for the purpose of providing a minimum of 25 percent (25%) for the capital improvement and the remainder for the maintenance and operation of the Fire Department.

Tax being a renewal of an existing tax of 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$22 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for five years. The estimated annual collection of this levy is \$96,000.

Notice is hereby given that in pursuance of a Resolution of the Board of Education of the Wooster City School District of Wooster, Ohio, passed on the 17th day of December, 2024, there will be submitted to a vote of the people at the Primary/Special Election to be held at the regular places of voting on Tuesday, the 6th day of May, 2025 the question of issuing bonds in the principal amount of Sixty-seven million dollars (\$67,000,000) for the purpose of constructing, furnishing and equipping a new middle school, renovating, rehabilitating, remodeling, constructing, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving other school district buildings and facilities, and acquiring, clearing, equipping, and otherwise improving sites for those school district building and facilities.

The maximum number of years over which the principal of the bonds may be paid is 36 years. The estimated additional average annual property tax levy amounts to \$119 for each on hundred thousand dollars of the county auditor's appraised value, which is 3.4 mills for each one dollar in excess of the tax limitation as estimated and certified by the County Auditor. The first calendar year in which the tax is expected to be due is 2026.

The polls for the election will be open at 6:30 a.m. and remain open until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day.
